Ms. Sapaugh joins us from Winnsboro ISD in Winnsboro, Texas where she was the assistant director at Winnsboro Junior High for five years. Under her direction, Ms. Sapaugh's bands were consistent UIL Sweepstakes recipients. Ms. Sapaugh has also coached a number of small ensembles that have received 1st Division ratings at the region and state level. Additionally, Ms. Sapaugh assisted the Winnsboro High School Marching Band as they advanced to the UIL 3A State Marching Contest for the first time in school history, where they finished 5th in 2021.

Prior to Winnsboro, Ms. Sapaugh worked at Prescott School District in Prescott, Arkansas for two years as the assistant director. While at Prescott her bands received 1st division ratings and were the first 2A State Marching Champions in 2016.
